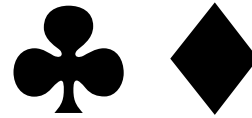

West led the ♠10 to the Jack and Queen. East shifted to a low heart won by Harold's Ace. At this point it was important to keep West off lead, so a club was led to the 10-spot and East's Jack. Another heart was returned won by the Jack.

To combine all his chances, Declarer led the 8-spot of Diamonds and when West didn't cover he let it ride to the 9. East got out with the ♥ Queen. The Club King was cashed and West threw a spade. Harold had lost 3 tricks and the hands now looked like this:
