The defense started with the ♥Q taken by the ace, and the littlest diamond came back, ruffed and overruffed with the ace. The *eight* of clubs was then led for a ruff and followed by a second heart for a penalty of 800. Winthrop Allegaert repeated the 6♦ opening, but it went all pass at the other table, resulting in a pedestrian 3 IMP pickup for *Allegaert* on an exotic deal. If south returns one of his low clubs to be ruffed, declarer would still have had to lose another club trick for a penalty of 1100 and a 5 IMP *loss* for *Allegaert*, a costly 8 IMP swing. Another hand from the set demonstrated both sides bidding judgment. (See next column) At both tables, east/west first found their eight card spade fit and then rejected it in favor of 3 no trump. 4 spades has no real play. *Allegaert* managed to declare 3 no trump from the west, which appears to be impregnable. *Morgen* was not so lucky. The ♥T was led to the queen and ace, and a small heart ducked to south's nine. South now found a club shift. Your modest bulletin editor has been told that the contract can still be made after running the spades, forcing north to discard a diamond and a

club and leading to an endplay. However, with no clues from the bidding to tell him that all of the key cards lay in the north hand, Shuster took an alternate line and finished one down, and another 12 IMPs swung to *Allegaert*.

### HOSPITALITY

## PARKING

### *Parking in the Evening*

The DoubleTree parking fee is \$3.00 for vehicles entering after 5:00 p.m. No vouchers will be given.

### *During the Day, Tuesday - Friday*

When the DoubleTree garage is full drivers will be directed to the Courthouse garage, on the same side of King Street, one-half block past the DoubleTree.

The special tournament daily charge will be \$5.00 all day at either the hotel or Courthouse lot.

**The driver must come to the Parking Table for a coupon. THE COUPONS ARE DIFFERENT FOR EACH PARKING GARAGE.**

To pay at the DoubleTree garage, the parking ticket is inserted in the machine at the exit gate and the regular \$8.00 fee is displayed. Then the driver inserts the coupon and the display shows \$5.00 owed.

### *Parking at the Courthouse*

At the Courthouse there are two payment machines at the walking entrance. The driver first inserts the parking ticket, the machine shows the regular fee (\$10.00), then the driver inserts the coupon and the fee shown is reduced to \$5.00. This \$5.00 has to be paid in cash or with a credit card. **At the exit gates, only credit cards can be used for payment. THE COURTHOUSE GARAGE WILL BE CLOSED AT MIDNIGHT EACH NIGHT!!!**

### *Saturday Parking*

The cost for parking at the hotel with a coupon will be \$3.00 for the day. Without the coupon the driver will have to pay the regular \$8.00 parking fee at the exit gate. **No validation coupons will be given for parking at the Courthouse garage on Saturday.**

### *Sunday Parking*

Parking is free at the hotel garage on Sunday. The courthouse garage is closed.

### *Doubletree Overnight Guests*

Overnight hotel guests have the parking fee on their hotel bill and tournament vouchers are not valid.

### *The Downtown Wilmington Bike Patrol*

The Downtown Wilmington Bike Patrol will be available to escort you from the Doubletree hotel back to the Courthouse garage lot. Information on this service is available outside the main ballroom.

## INTERMEDIATE AND NEWCOMER (I/N) PROGRAM

Separate events for those with fewer than 300 masterpoints (and non-Life Masters with more than 300 masterpoints) are available at every session. Special prizes are available for the players in these events, as well as a two-session trophy championship which is held daily. Those that are interested in gold points may also wish to enter some of the bracketed knockout events held throughout the week.

All non-Life Masters are invited to Suite 816 for a special hospitality event at 4PM on Thursday. Come enjoy some refreshments and meet some of the pro players attending the tournament.

## PRIZES

Prizes can be found in the coat room on the hotel's ground level, around the corner from the main ballroom. Jess and Lois Stuart and their committee members will open the room daily starting Wednesday, about forty five minutes before each afternoon and evening session. It will also be open for an hour after the Sunday Swiss Team. Prizes are awarded for the highest score each direction in all sections of match point play. There are not separate prizes for A, B and C strata in stratified sections, just a prize for the top section score. When two sections are scored together on a combined top, both first in A and second in A will receive section top prizes. There are no prizes for overall event winners, except that the Knockout and Swiss Team winners for each flight or stratum will be given section top prizes since there are no separate sections. The prizes include bridge books, golf balls and an assortment of household items.

Daily bulletins will be available every morning. You will find the day's schedule of bridge activities, a complete list of the previous day(s) winners, notices of any new Life Master's and *hopefully* an interesting bridge hand or two.
